How to get to Diliman, Quezon City

From Airports

- A.) Ninoy Aguino International Airport (NAIA) Terminal 1, 2 or 3
 - Various forms of public transportation can be used to take you to the Conference venue or to your chosen accommodations. Taxi services are the most convenient. Please go to https://bit.ly/NAIAtransport for more information on these services. Depending on your destination in Quezon City, taxi rates can range from PhP 600-1,200 (USD 10-20).
 - Take the UBE Point-to-Point (P2P) bus service to Araneta City, Cubao, Quezon City (fare: PhP 200 / USD 3.50). The bus departs from Terminal 3 at the hours indicated below. Passengers arriving at Terminal 1 and 2 will have to catch the UBE NAIA Loop bus (fare: PhP 50 / USD 0.85) to go to Terminal 3. From Araneta City, you can take a taxi to the Conference venue or to your chosen accommodations. White taxis can be flagged down when available. You can also download the Grab app, and use the "car" feature to book a ride.

B.) Clark International Airport

For passengers arriving at the Clark International Airport, there is a shuttle service operated by Genesis. Please see the schedule below. If your arrival time goes beyond the shuttle schedule, you will need to make your own special arrangements for airport pick up. Clark International Airport is easily accessible from Quezon City; however, it is in a different province. Taxi services are not able to transport passengers across provincial borders.



From PITX Bus station, Parañaque City (https://www.pitx.ph/)

- Take a taxi to the Conference venue or to your chosen accommodations.
 White taxis can be flagged down when available. You can also download the Grab app, and use the "car" feature to book a ride.
- Take an EDSA Carousel (https://edsacarousel.com/) Northbound bus and get off at the Quezon Avenue station / Centris Mall (fare: PhP 55.50 / USD 1.00). At Centris, you can hail a white taxi or book a ride using the Grab app, or take a jeepney to Philcoa (fare: PhP 15.00 / USD 0.26) to the Conference venue or your chosen accommodations. To go to Asian Center, UP Diliman, take another jeepney (labeled SM North, Pantranco, or Philcoa) to the Asian Center.

From Cubao Bus station, Quezon City

- Take a taxi to the Conference venue or to your chosen accommodations. White taxis can be flagged down when available. You can also download the Grab app, and use the "car" feature to book a ride.
- Use the rail transit system:

Option 1: MRT

Take the Northbound train to Quezon Avenue / Centris Mall (fare: PhP13.00). At Centris, you can hail a white taxi or book a ride using the Grab app, or take a jeepney to Philcoa (fare: PhP 13.00-15.00) to the Conference venue or your chosen accommodations. To go to Asian Center, UP Diliman, take another jeepney (labeled SM North, Pantranco, or Philcoa) to the Asian Center.

Option 2: LRT2

Take the train (heading to Antipolo) and get off at the Katipunan station (fare: PhP 15.00). From the station, you can hail a white taxi or book a ride using the Grab app, or take a Katipunan jeepney (fare: PhP 13.00-15.00) to the GT Toyota Asian Center gate of UP Diliman. The jeepney station is located under the flyover at the intersection of Katipunan Ave. and Aurora Blvd.
